

Highlights

- Students at UNLV come from every county in Nevada, every state in the U.S., and 64 foreign countries.
- Undergraduate headcount enrollment increased by 5.7% and undergraduate student FTE by 5.0% during the past year.
- Almost 25% of freshmen report that they are not native speakers of English.
- Nationally, about 80% of students work during college UNLV's students' work and debt expectations are similar to national norms.
- Students who start at UNLV take an average of 5.4 years to complete a baccalaureate degree.
- 44.6% of UNLV newly admitted undergraduate students transfer credits from another institution.
