Master's level FTE - All semester instruction in graduate-level courses generated by non-doctoral students, divided by 12.

Doctoral level FTE - All semester instruction generated by doctoral students in graduate-level courses, divided by 9.

Headcount Enrollment Unduplicated count of student enrollment in academic credit courses.
