CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE TO THE STRUCTURE OF THIS FILE. Please review these instructions carefully. It is important that instructions are followed as these files are loaded to a data warehouse and the file structure affects the load. Please pay particular attention to the following:

- It is important that ALL columns are included in your file, even if there is no data contained in them.
- Do NOT add additional columns. The file structure must be exactly the same for each institution.

Note: *Courses ending after June 10 and prior to the start date of the fall semester are considered summer term courses.* Summer term student credit hours are non-state supported, except for nursing courses and science-based nursing prerequisites and major requirement. Enrollments in courses with a start date three weeks prior to the start date of the fall semester will be recorded in the following fall if the course is included on the fall semester transcript and credits are applied toward the fall semester load.

For inclusion in the NSHE Course Taxonomy database, submit a file containing Summer student-level enrollments in undergraduate nursing courses, as well as science-based nursing prerequisites. The following reporting criteria must be followed.

Reporting Criteria

Individual Student Records: The file is composed of individual student records, one record per student per course. If a student is taking three different reportable courses, then there will be three records for that student – each of the three records containing one of the student's course-sections.

Formula Funded Enrollments: Records should be created for all students enrolled in undergraduate nursing courses leading to an associate or baccalaureate degree, as well as all science-based nursing prerequisites and major requirements¹. For the science-based prerequisites and major requirements, students must possess a nursing or pre-nursing major code in SIS in order to be included in the file.

Reporting Date: The file should represent nursing and science-based prerequisite enrollment on August 31. This STAT file should be generated on the same date as your official enrollment report for the summer term.
